Those who practice Tai Chi in Montgomery County will soon have a new court to enjoy. Construction of Montgomery County's new Tai Chi Court at Cabin John Regional Park began Monday, following a groundbreaking ceremony Saturday. The court, slated for completion in July, is dedicated to David C. Chen, the late founder of the Wu Wei Tai Chi Club who led tai chi practices in the park. The flat, hard-surfaced area will provide space for the practice of tai chi, yoga, meditation, martial arts and dance.
